HOUSEHOLD TOXINS

- Acids (drain and toilet cleaners)
- Alkalis (ammonia, lye and some drain and toilet cleaners)
- Batteries
- Bleach
- Enzymatic cleaners (used for breaking down proteins and organic matter)
- Glow jewelry
- Hydrocarbons (gasoline and motor oil)
- Ice melt products
- Liquid potpourri
- Mothballs
- Paint solvents and lacquers
- Paintballs
- Pine oil/essential oils
- Solvents (cleaners to remove oil, grease, and grime)
- Teflon-coated cookware

TOXINS AND POISONS

- Topical spot-on insecticides
- Household cleaners
- Antidepressants
- Lilies
- Insoluble oxalate Plants (e.g. dieffenbachia, philodendron)
- Human and veterinary pain relievers
- Acetaminophen (e.g. Tylenol)
- Glow sticks
- ADD/ADHD medications/ amphetamines
- Mouse and rat poisons
